Potentially, after flagging a high-dose finding:



Investigational question:

• Are there specific scanners or scan protocols that contribute to the high-dose finding?



- Example: CT HEAD BRAIN WO CONTRAST
  - I already know this exam has a median dose index that is 1.35 times the registry, and I would like to investigate further.
  - This prior information may have been obtained from the DIR Executive Summary Report OR from the CT Facility Comparison Report (Top 10 Exams filter.

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#### Summary

- Starting point: The CT HEAD BRAIN WO CONTRAST exam was known to have a high median dose index (CTDIvol maximum across scans).
  - Median CTDIvol: Facility: 64 mGy, Registry: 48 mGy, (1.3 facility/median ratio)
- We used the DIR to find the median dose index for each scanner at the facility. A bimodal distribution was observed.
  - One group of scanners with dose index of 1.3 times the registry median
  - Second group of scanners with dose index of 1.0 times the registry median
  - The group with the lower dose index used TCM, whereas the higher group did not.
- Potential follow-up:
  - Investigate a potential dose reduction using TCM in the first group of scanners.



Investigational question:

• What is the incidence of incorrect CT protocol selection at the scanner?

Example:

• Let's find the distributions of scan protocols used for the CT CHEST WO IVCON exam.

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# Summary

- We used the DIR to find the scan protocol used in individual CT CHEST WO IVCON exams.
- Potential follow-up:
  - Education/discussion with technologist staff on protocol selection
  - Review the % SOP-compliance again after intervention



Investigational question:

• How can I compare the performance for multiple facilities within my corporate account for exams with the highest volume?

Example:

• Let's investigate performance of the facilities within my corporate account for the top 10 exams performed and then drill down to the details.



**Report Parameters:** 

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- Results for the last quarter in 2023
- Comparison to 2023 data (Last Year)
- Adults only
- For top-ten exams by volume
- For exam type volume of at least 90 cases for the quarter
- All body areas and exam names for all facilities
- Comparison group: Entire registry
- Comparison Percentile: All
